

## **Trinity Preschool Fast Facts**

**Registration:** Applications for 2022-2023 will be available online. Forms and tuition information will be distributed via email or can be located on our website in early 2022.

### **Philosophy:**

Play based: Children learn best through hands-on exploration and discovery!!

### **Hours of Operation:**

9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon regular school day. Before and aftercare available. Our school year runs from September through June.

### **Curriculum:**

Trinity Preschool has adopted **Creative Curriculum** which includes developmentally appropriate goals and objectives for children within four main categories of interest: social/emotional, physical, cognitive and language. The social/emotional stage helps promote independence, self-confidence, and self-control. Emphasis is placed on responding to children's learning styles and building on their strengths and interests.

- Parent-teacher conferences twice a year.
- Lesson plans and weekly schedules shared with families.
- Weekly newsletters and daily photographs via Brightwheel app document classroom activities and progress.
- Brightwheel app and email communications for each classroom.

### **Other Scheduled Activities:**

- Daily scheduled outside recess times. Two separate fenced playgrounds: One is a large blacktop for balls and bikes, the second a smaller mulched area used as an outdoor classroom.
- Large indoor playrooms for all children. \*\*
- Group Time: once a week with the Head of School. \*\*
- Chapel: once a month with Pastor Grace Han in individual classrooms.
- Scheduled in-house field trips

### **Discipline:**

Positive guidance, supervision, and redirection are used, providing a developmentally appropriate environment for each child.

### **Security:**

Doors are locked all day. Children are only released to parents or caretakers who have been given written authorization. ID is checked.

### **Parents provide:**

- Diapers and wipes
- Healthy snacks and lunches
- We are a nut-free school

### **Extended Day and Enrichment Programs:**

Jump Start 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.

Lunch Bunch 12:00pm – 1:30pm

Fall, Winter, and Spring Enrichment Sessions  
12:00pm – 2:00 p.m.

### **Enrichment Programs may include, but are not limited to:**

Spanish Immersion, Literacy, Art Expression, Curious Kids (STEAM), Hip Hop/Zumba, Ballet, Cooking Club and Yoga
